Accuracy

Refers to the closeness of measurements to the correct value.

Precision

 Refers to the <u>closeness of a set of</u> <u>measurements</u> of the same quantity made in the same way. Therefore, measured values that are precise are <u>close to one another</u>, but not necessarily close to the accepted value.
